Metal Considered to be extremely durable and hard-wearing, metal tiles are mainly made of aluminium and steel. "Metal can be used in small 12" x 12" tile forms or even in mosaic form for the floor, as well as the wall in coding and treatments. Use water: Regular moping with plain water is the key to keeping all types of tiles in great shape. You can use white vinegar with warm water, which does not react with tiles. Avoid detergents to retain the sheen.

Grout lines: When it comes to cleaning tiles – be it floor or walls, it's important to take care of the grout as well. For all that dust and grime that makes enough space to stick in the grout and spoil the entire look of the tile, you can start by spraying the grout with hot water, followed by scrubbing with a grout brush and then cleaning the surface. "You can even use a baking soda and water mixture with a toothbrush to scrub the grout," recommends Sapna. Avoid scrubbing: "Never clean your tiles with a hard scrub as it may give more harm than benefit to the tiles. You can use an old towel or a soft cloth to wipe them clean," she cautions.

Cover or seal: If you have porous tiles, it is advisable to seal them using a floor sealer to prevent them from becoming too porous.
